November 23rd

Copenhagen Opera House



The Copenhagen Opera House, Operaen, is a unique building designed by Danish architect Henning Larsen with commissioned artworks by Danish artists such as Per Arnoldi and Per Kirkeby. All levels of the marble-clad foyer offer sweeping views of Renaissance Copenhagen and the city harbour. A restaurant with a roof terrace is situated on the top floor offering a panoramic view of the Royal Palace, Amalienborg, and the adjacent domed Marble Church.

Experience the extensive backstage facilities consisting of five mobile stage units as well as a small experimental stage, Takkelloftet, in addition to the auditorium and the rehearsal and training rooms for the ballet and the opera. 2 Opera singers will perform for the group exclusively for 10-15 minutes.

After the visit at the Opera the tour continues on bicycles.

Cross the new bicycle bridge that connects the Island of Holmen with the city of Copenhagen. Pass by the old harbor area Nyhavn and drive to the symbol of Copenhagen, The Little Mermaid, where a special surprise awaits the guests.

The Little Mermaid & Divers



The statue of the Little Mermaid, picturing her as she sits and looks out over the water, longing for a prince and the opportunity to live a normal life, was unveiled at her present location on August 23rd 1913. No more than 1,25 metre high, the mermaid has – at various times - had her head and arm sawn off and been smeared with paint but still she still gazes – fully restored – serenely out to sea, turning her head away from the life and love that could never be hers.

While the guide tells you the story about the Little Mermaid a surprise awaits you – divers will appear from the sea with bottles of champagne and a company logo to Welcome you to Copenhagen.

Sølyst is the perfect choice for a top class gala dinner in the most exclusive surroundings. The venue often serves for the Royal Court.

After the lunch a shooting competitions will take place. The guests are standing inside, shooting with a rifle through a hole in a window towards a target placed in the garden.

BDP comment: Elegant and historical mansion, and yet you feel like dinner in a private home. Superb food!

Mikkeller beer tasting



Mikkeller was founded in 2006 and has quickly become an important part of Copenhagen's beer scene. Today the founder, Mikkel Borg Bjergsø, exports his micro brewed beer to 40 different countries and is internationally acclaimed as one of the most innovative and cutting edge brewers in the world. This beer tasting will take place in either Baghaven, a bar placed in an industrial area – Refshaleøen – or in the hip Vesterbro location, Warpigs, which is a restaurant and bar located in the Meat Packing district. An expert from Mikkeller will host.

In the evening transfer from the hotel to a gourmet dinner in one of Copenhagen's best restaurants.

Geranium is one of Copenhagen's two, two-starred Michelin-starred restaurants. It was also ranked the 45th Best Restaurant in the World in 2013 by Fine Dining Lovers, and is run by Rasmus Kofoed who was awarded with world's best chef in 2011.

Geranium is a lucid, light and dynamic kitchen. The mission is to create meals that involve all senses – restoring, challenging and enriching. The restaurant is situated on the 8th floor in Fælledparken and the location emphasizes Geranium's vision of gastronomic clarity and diversity.

The chef at Geranium is Rasmus Kofoed, won the world championships in cooking - better known as the Bocuse d'Or - in 2011, furthermore he is a triple winner of the gold, silver and bronze medals - the most awarded chef in Bocuse D'ore-competitions ever. Geranium is awarded two Michelin stars.

BDP comment: A must for food lovers.

November 25th

Before returning to the UK it is time to experience a real adrenalin rush – first in Rib Boats when crossing the Øresund the sound between Denmark and Sweden and then when having a fun competition at a race track.
